

Summary of GSA's New MAS Ordering Rules

New ordering rules do not apply to BPAs awarded prior to May 17, 2011.

Notification must be given to unsuccessful offerors, with a brief explanation if requested, where a BPA award is based on factors other than price alone.
Above the Simplified Acquisition Threshold	<p><i>(in addition to above)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide RFQ (with description of supplies/ services and selection criteria) to as many contractors as practicable or post on e-Buy. ▪ Consider all quotes IAW the RFQ. ▪ Document if fewer than 3 quotes received (unless e-Buy is used). ▪ Select best value. 	<p><i>(in addition to above)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide RFQ (with SOW and evaluation criteria) to as many contractors as practicable or post on e-Buy. ▪ Consider all quotes IAW the RFQ. ▪ Document if fewer than 3 quotes received (unless e-Buy is used). ▪ Select best value. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Provide RFQ to all BPA holders with description of supplies/services and selection criteria. ▪ Afford all responding an opportunity to submit a quote. ▪ Consider all quotes IAW the RFQ. ▪ Document compliance with process. 	<p>The Rule expresses a preference for multiple award BPAs, and precludes single award BPAs over \$103M in most cases.</p> <p>Multiple Award BPAs generally should not exceed five years in duration.</p> <p>Single Award BPAs shall not exceed one-year and may have up to 4 one-year options only.</p> <p>All BPAs still are subject to annual review to ensure best value.</p>

Simplified Acquisition Threshold: \$150,000
